

ACO 2025 Medical Mission Registration

The 2025 Senegal Medical Mission trip is open for registration until October 30. Medical and non-medical professionals are welcome to apply. Spots are limited and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. As in previous years, we will have general medicine, surgery, and dentistry teams.

1. Registration: click the following link, <https://form.jotform.com/242185782425158>, sign the registration form, and sign the waiver form. Each family must contribute a non-refundable registration fee of \$1,000, which will be used to fund medication, rice, equipment, and hospital rental fees for the locals in Senegal.

Additionally, each person's accommodation, food, and transportation costs will be \$1,100. If there are

two people in your family, the cost is \$2,200, and so on.

If this is your third year participating in the Africa Cries Out team, the registration fee is \$500.

For the

fourth year or more, the fee is \$250.

2. Dates: There are two groups:

- Group 1: Departure on Friday, March 7, returning on Thursday, March 13.

- Group 2: Departure on Friday, March 14, returning on Sunday, March 23.

3. Flights: Please purchase your own tickets. Pay close attention to the departure and arrival times, which

are very important. Direct flights from Air Senegal and Delta Airlines are available. Information can be

group price is much higher than the individual one. After you purchase the flight ticket, please input your

flight information in the above form and send it to Acoenroll@gmail.com.

Group 1: Boarding on Friday, March 7 at 1:30 AM at JFK Airport in New York. Please arrive at the airport

three hours in advance to help distribute medications, phones, computers, etc. Arrival in Dakar at 14:50

PM on the same day. Departure from Dakar on Friday, March 14 at 4:00 AM.

Group 2: Boarding on Friday, March 14 at 1:30 AM at JFK Airport in New York. Again, arrive three hours

early to help with distribution. Arrival in Dakar at 14:50 PM on the same day. Departure from Dakar on

Sunday, March 23 at 4:00 AM.

After booking your tickets, please return to the Africa Cries website to register your flight information to ensure someone is available for pick-up.

4. Items to Collect: Please start gathering second-hand phones, computers, 90% new sports shoes, over-the-counter anti-inflammatory and pain medications, vitamins, toys, new toothpaste, and toothbrushes.

You can discuss donations with the parents' companies, major phone and computer dealers, and schools

for their retired electronics. Also, approach Walmart, CVS, and Costco for free vitamins, toothpaste,

toothbrushes, and other medications. Discuss with major shoe stores for donations, as we need sports

shoes and slippers. Africa Cries Out can provide a certificate if necessary.

5. Vaccinations: Consult your family doctor for CDC-recommended vaccinations, mainly typhoid, hepatitis A, and yellow fever vaccines. Passport Health, CVS, and others offer vaccination services
